The Colorado Water Assembly is working with several other organizations and agencies to develop a list of projects that could be eligible for some federal funding through the Federal Technical Assistance Grant Program. The program is intended to provide grants to eligible entities to assist with capacity and resources to pursue federal funding opportunities that directly support the Colorado Water Plan objectives. We have some capacity and are seeking more funding to be able to provide assistance. Funding can be used for preliminary project planning and design, preliminary permitting, development of estimated project costs, navigation of available federal opportunities, grant writing, and federal grant application submission. The ultimate goal of the program, and a required element of every funded project, is the submission of one or more applications seeking federal funding for further project work.
