The Eastside Lift Station and project are identified within the City of Loveland’s currently approved Utility Plan.

The rationale explanations include the number of samples and resulting ambient water quality related to the unattaining water quality standard that the Water Quality Control Division used for 303(d) listing.

Recommendation: Membership should identify, recommend, and prioritize the development of TMDLs in the region to improve water quality, which members initiate and agree to locally.
